

ateb Trust Application Form



The ateb Trust provides grants to individuals, community groups, and projects that enhance wellbeing and improve communities within areas where ateb works. Grants are awarded to initiatives that align with our purpose of enabling better living through safe, secure, and stable homes.

Our Purpose

We believe a home is more than just a building - it's a foundation for living well. The ateb Trust supports:

- Community capacity building and self-sufficiency.
- Community regeneration through social, economic, environmental, and wellbeing programmes.
- Supporting older and vulnerable people to remain in their homes and communities as their needs change.

Grants aim to create sustainable opportunities for those who need them most, enhancing the lives of ateb customers and their communities.

Funding Details

- **Grant Limit:** Up to £1,500 per project or activity.
- **Funding Rounds:** Open in July, October, and January, with decisions made in August, November, and February.

Applicants must demonstrate how their project supports ateb's purpose, its impact on communities, and long-term sustainability. Evidence of costs and a breakdown of funding use are required.

Criteria

Projects should empower communities by sharing skills, information, or training to ensure sustainable benefits beyond the grant. Funding cannot be used for:

- Single individuals or families; impact must benefit wider groups.
- Activities or projects covered by other income sources (e.g., rents, service charges).
- Salaries (external expertise may be considered).
- Projects exceeding £1,500 or contributing to larger funding pots.

Applications must adhere to governance regulations and cannot contravene housing legislation. Constituted ateb tenant associations and non-profit organisations are welcome to apply.
